The scope of the services requires two (2) Product Tankers for the marine transport of bulk petroleum products from Paria Fuel Trading Company Limited (Paria) in Pointe-a-Pierre to NP's Terminals at Sea Lots, Trinidad and Crown Point, Tobago respectively for a two-year period, with the option to terminate by providing three (3) months' notice.
