LPG FLOOD SAFETY TIPS

LPG Cylinders that have only been immersed in floodwaters are still fit for use and should not be discarded. However, if cylinders show signs of damage such as dents, digs, gouges, damage to valves or the body of the cylinders, follow these rules to ensure safe usage:



DO NOT place damaged LPG cylinders on the streets with your general garbage for disposal. An approved LPG Distributor or the nearest Retailer should be contacted to make the necessary exchange.

Only NP-Recommended LPG Installation Contractors of 100lb cylinders should remove or repair any LPG piping or related appliances. For a full list of approved LPG Installation Contractors/Distributors visit the NP website or the TSTT yellow pages.



DO NOT use a cylinder if a leak is suspected - check for leaks by using soapy water on the cylinder valve and connections to the appliance, and always dry the connection when finished.
