LABORATORY TECHNICIAN (CONTRACT)

The Laboratory Technician (Contract) is generally accountable for facilitating process decision-making by performing testing as required in accordance with established test methods and Company's quality procedures.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Validates quality of raw materials, blended, inprocess and finished petroleum based products by performing the established control tests in accordance with the schedule of laboratory tests and evaluating results against control specifications.
- Assists in preparing the blending requisition as well as supervises blending procedures as required.
- Assists in determining corrective actions for off specification petroleum based products to ensure conformance to specifications.
- Verifies for approval, the discharge of petroleum based products from vessels in accordance with the Company's QMS.
- Provides laboratory services by way of inspection of bulk storage tanks, tanktainers and IBCs to establish usability as required.
- Contributes to ensuring that all formulations are current and updated when new base oils and additives are received by preparing and testing trial blends.
- Maintains the Company's QMS and ISO accreditation by participating in Proficiency Testing, Interlaboratory Cross-check Programmes and audits.
- Monitors the inventory levels of chemicals and spares for equipment.

- Conducts laboratory tours and assists in the development of new recruits/trainees by providing guidance as required.
- Performs all duties in conformance to requirements of ISO/ IEC 17025:2017, ISO 9001:2015 and the organization's policies and procedures.
- Practices safe work habits, carries out general housekeeping duties and complies with all safety, health and environmental rules and regulations.
